Riggins Construction & Management is honored to have performed dramatic design-build tenant and exterior building and site improvements for a 20,000 square foot, run-down and overstocked pottery supply warehouse, subsequently transformed into a beautiful auto showroom and automotive service center.

Where there had only been one obscure, arched entry on the far left (which was straightened out), we sawcut into the tilt-up panels to make room for a grand, dark bronze, anodized-aluminum storefront entry in the center of the north elevation. A symmetrical window was added on the right side of the main entry as well as an additional storefront and a service bay entrance on the west elevation.

Storefront modification mandated that we erect a structural (shear) wall separating the auto service bay area from the office / showroom which required structural tie-ins to both the concrete footings as well as the roof and updated seismic retrofitting.

All of the existing interior, including a mezzanine, was entirely gutted; a prefabricated mezzanine was installed for auto parts storage in its place as well a 3,250 square foot showroom and 1,252 square feet of offices and 15,500 square feet of service bays.

Other features of this project include: speciality automotive hoists and equipment, exterior auto wash area with a below-grade water clarifier and rain detection system, smog station, and a specialty hi/low exhaust system in the service bay area.
